5. Orientation training for the in-service Physical education teachers.

It is organized at Circle Level in collaboration with resource person of the circle and state in different games in order to enhance the technical know-how of the PETs in report of officiating and coaching the games.

JUNIOR RED CROSS:

Junior Red Cross is a sisterwing of Indian Red Cross Society. Motto of Junior Red Cross is “Health-Service and Friendship”. Each High School student is recognized on a junior and the teacher in charge is called the counselor. School students render volunteer social service in their own locality during festival, natural calamities and helps volunteer organization in adult education, health education, illiteracy programme, blood grouping, plantation, environmental sanitation, blood donation, eradication of evils like drug addition, superstition etc.

A circle level Junior Red Cross study-cum-training camp is organized annually basing on the activities and theme “Health Service and Friendship”.

The circle contingent, selected on the basis of performance in circle programme are sent for participation in state and inter-state Junior Red Cross Study-cum-Training Programme and Governors Cup Competition in Art, Essay and Elocution. They get wide exposure by participating in such state and inter-state JRC Camps.

The Inspector of Physical Education attached to each Inspectorate of Schools is vested with the responsibility of looking after the games, sports, scouts and guides and JRC programme.
