INTRODUCTION

Koraput district occupies an important place in the Orissa State because of its large concentration of Tribal population. The entire District falls under Vth Scheduled Areas which is mostly characterised by pre-ponderance of tribal population, undulating hilly terrain, forest growths etc.

Out of the entire Scheduled areas (69613.80 Sq.Kms) of the State Koraput District occupies 12.26%. Out of the 62 ethnic groups found in the State Thirteen tribes are found in the District. They are Kandha, Paraja, Bhatoda, Gadaba, Kotia, Bhumia, Duruba, Halva, Bhotra, Pentia, Kondadora, Santal, Soura and Omanatya. Among them Kandha and Paraja are the most populated tribes with population of more than one lakh each. Bhattoda and Gadba have a population of more than 50,000.

The sex ratio among the STs of the district is 1000 Males : 1018 females which is favourable against the sex ratio of the district as a whole which is 1000: 999.

Forestry and agriculture are the main stay of tribal life and their economy is largely depends upon it. Ownership over forest land/ forest used for agriculture and other allied activities traditionally by the Tribals over the generation was remain unaddressed. The recent formulation & implementation of the Scheduled Tribes & Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 is a historical step to provide justice to the tribal and other traditional forest dwellers. Besides dovetailing of funds from other anti-poverty schemes of the Govt. for land development, plantation, soil and water conservation etc. on the forest land for which rights has been provided is being implemented to improve the livelihood of the marginalised tribals & other traditional forest dwellers.
